CHOREOGRAPHER

The Choreographer works to create the Director's vision through the movement of the musical — they must work closely with the Director.

- The Choreographer is responsible for designing dances that may be needed and teaching them to the cast.
- Most of the dances that are used should be fairly simple and easy to learn.
- The director will usually have a vision of what the dance should look like, where it should take place, and so on
- The choreographer 's responsibility is to make that vision happen on stage.
